



Qualifying Presentation

- When ready, present to camp meeting or area workshop (& video-record as well)
- Can be conducted in a church-like setting (but not in an actual church service)
- Evaluated by mentor and other church presenters
- Self-evaluate qualification video (we are often our own best/worst critic!)

5 Key Questions:

- 1. How effectively did the presentation inspire, encourage and challenge you?
- 2. How effectively did the presenter make use of the given time?
- 3. How effectively did the presenter's verbal communication contribute to the presentation?

5. How would you honestly describe the presenter to your own pastor?



Qualifying Presentation

- Members privately discuss their evaluation of the presentation with mentor
- Mentor provides personal summary of feedback, making any suggestions for improvement
- If unsuccessful, try again asap!
- If feedback is favourable, submit video to state church ministry co-ordinator for review and official approval



- Seek feedback from pastor and prayer partner after every presentation
- Supply a copy of the Gideon presentation evaluation form (Item 215)
- Keep presentation fresh with new testimonies
- Vary length of presentation as requested

Retain Your Qualification

- Present in a church at least once every 2 years
- If a negative report is received from pastor and/ort prayer partner and is substantiated, presenter must requalify
- Submit recent pastor feedback form (within last 12 months) and video of recent live or 8-minute mock church presentation (within last 6 months) to state assessment team every 3 years for official approval
